Student attendance generally, absence at the start of Term 1 and absence due to family holidays

This is an area of improvement for our school.

Students are expected to attend school for all school days each term unless they are ill or otherwise not fit to be at school.

We are experiencing an increasing number of families taking extended leave for holidays, mainly overseas. This impacts on student learning and wellbeing. Daily school attendance is important for all children and young people to succeed in education and to ensure they don't fall behind both socially and developmentally.

Parents and Carers have a legal obligation to ensure that their children attend school each day and I, as Principal, expect our students to attend school and have an obligation to communicate these expectations to our school community.

I am also required to discuss requests for extended family leave from school with parents/carers who are planning to take their children out of school for more than two weeks, and I do not necessarily have to approve of this absence.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.
