I loved swimming, it was so fun! I really liked Rescue Day! - Aailya 2M


My favourite part of swimming was the day when we got to do lots of different dives and then we could jump off a wall and swim to the teacher - it was so much fun! - Urvi 2M

Swimming was lots of fun! We really liked learning how to swim with different people from Year 2. Freestyle and soldier kicking were our favourite swimming techniques. - 2L












NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS STORYTIME
